# History

The "Horsforth Golf Club" was formed by a number of residents on 8th November, 1906. Funds were immediately raised by eighteen gentlemen promising Life Membership for themselves and their wives.



It was soon decided to form a Company limited by guarantee and take lease of land on the Rawdon Estate from W.E.J. Green-Emmott embracing about 80 acres situate near Rawdon Billing.



So quickly did the membership grow that the erection of the present Clubhouse was soon warranted, the necessary funds being raised by the issue of Debentures amongst the members and on 10th

August, 1907 the Links and Clubhouse were officially opened.

1913 the Clubhouse was destroyed by fire but the replacement was soon in operation.



Horsforth joined the Leeds and District Union of Golf Clubs upon its formation in 1920. The Clubhouse was altered in 1921 to provide further accommodation and a locker room, and in 1923 the putting green was laid in front of the Clubhouse.



Part of the course was requisitioned by the Air Ministry in 1942 and subsequent to the war relatively little development took place during the 1940s and the whole of the 1950s. Airport extensions in the 1960s led to an anxious time for the Club but in 1964 plans for the reconstruction of

the course were agreed. These included the new 16th and 17th holes, shortening of the 3rd, discarding of the short 7th and the lengthening of the 6th to a new green.

# The Course

This parkland and moorland course, designed by Dr Alistair Mackenzie always presented in good condition, combines devilish short holes with some altogether more substantial challenges.



The heathland the course was built on is slowly changing due to tree planting over the last thirty years. The course was once catchment land for Horsforth water authority, two of the abandoned reservoirs forming part of the course boundary.

The 1<sup>st</sup> begins with a slight incline away from the Clubhouse and is protected by a ditch on the right and OOB on the left, the course continues by offering a variety of par 3's & 4's and ending with a par 5.

The short par-four 10th and long closing hole are perhaps outstanding examples. The former, at little over 300 yards, offers the adventurous the opportunity to drive the green by taking on a blind shot with out-of-bounds inside the angle of the left-hand dog-leg. Those laying up will find even a wedge approach to the narrow ledge of a green a ticklish proposition. The 18<sup>th</sup>, meanwhile is close to 550 yards long and plays over the brow of a hill before the s-shaped fairway tumbles down to a green protected by a stream at the front, with the spacious clubhouse providing a fitting backdrop.

The Clubhouse, for a small room hire fee, offers good facilities for off site meetings, conferences and parties or social get togethers.

# Membership Categories

At Horsforth Golf Club we welcome enquiries for several different types of membership.

We have Full Membership (7 day playing), 6 Day Membership (Sunday to Friday playing), 5 Day Membership (Monday to Friday playing) along with Associate (21—30 yrs), Student and Junior Membership. All the above have full use of the Clubhouse etc and, with the exception of the Juniors, can attend the many functions held throughout the year. These are available for both males and females although there are restrictions on the numbers allowed in the individual categories at any one time so you may not be able to join at your preferred category immediately.

We offer several payment plans and fees are pro rata depending on the month of joining, although the summer months are “weighted” as this is the main playing season.

We also offer Social Membership allowing members to enjoy the Clubhouse and Golf Practice facilities and also to attend the many Social functions held, usually at least one a month.

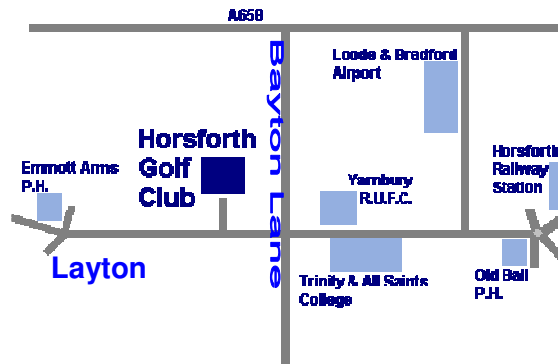
